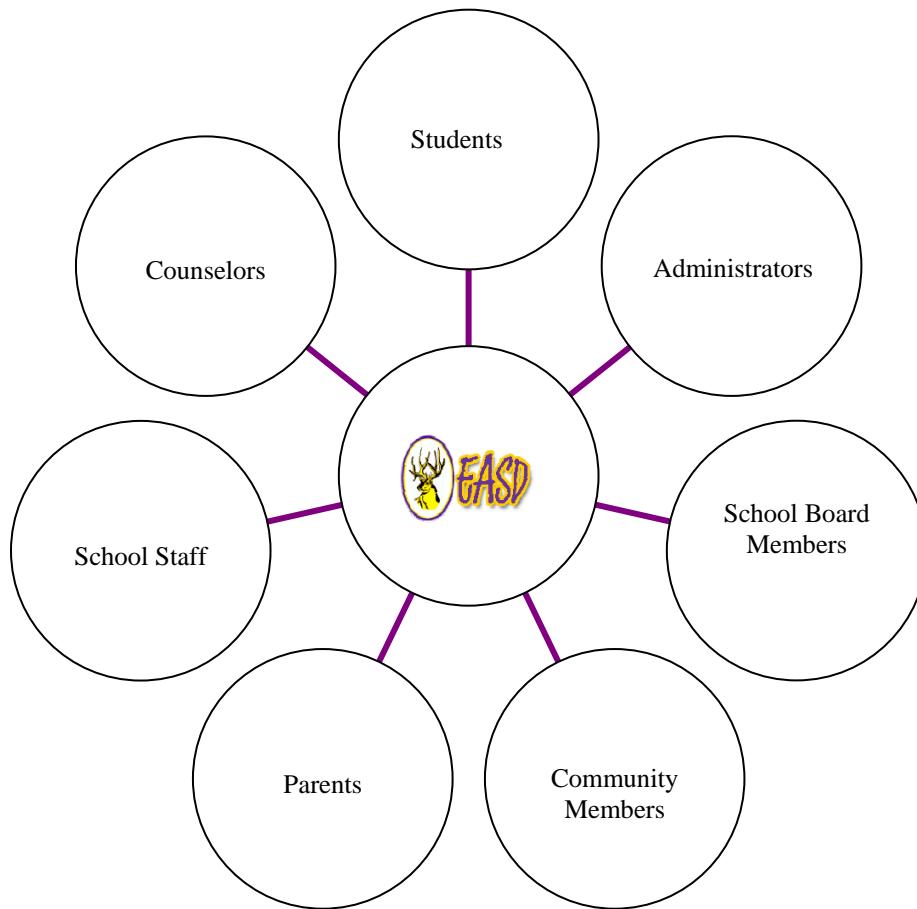

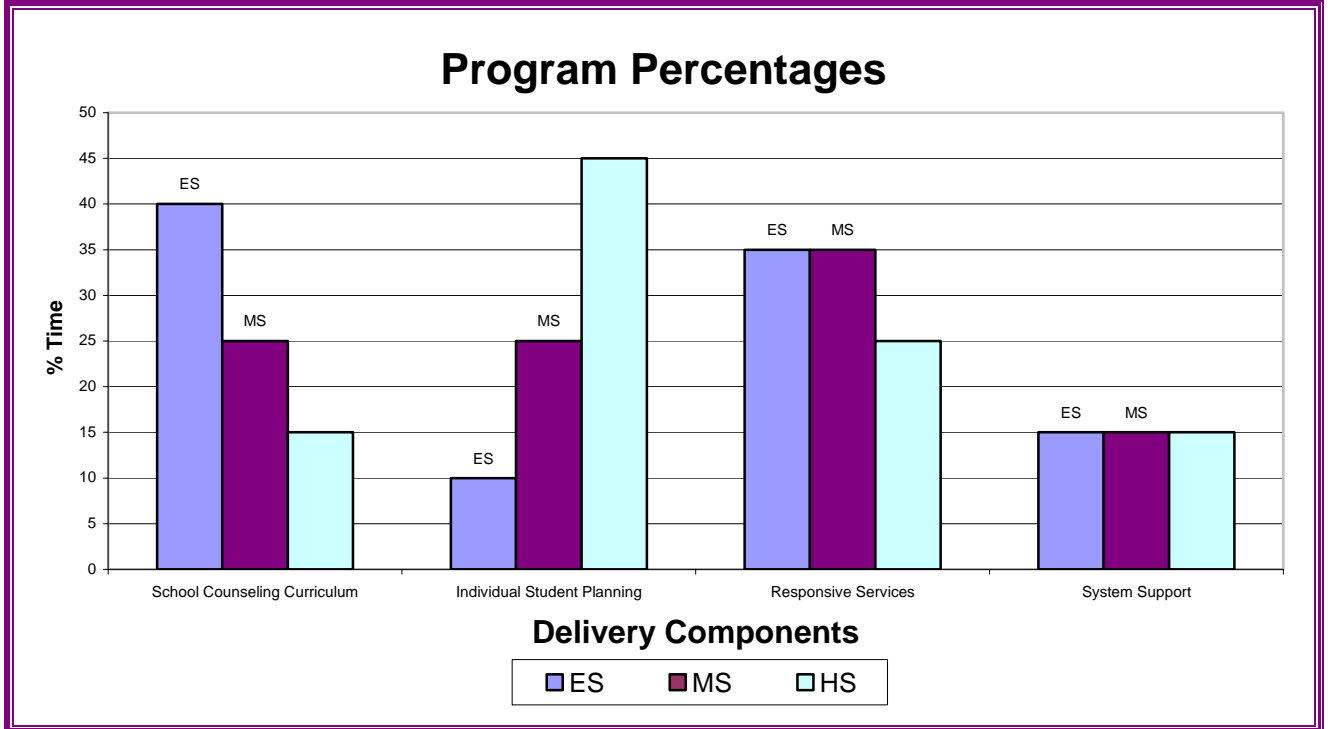

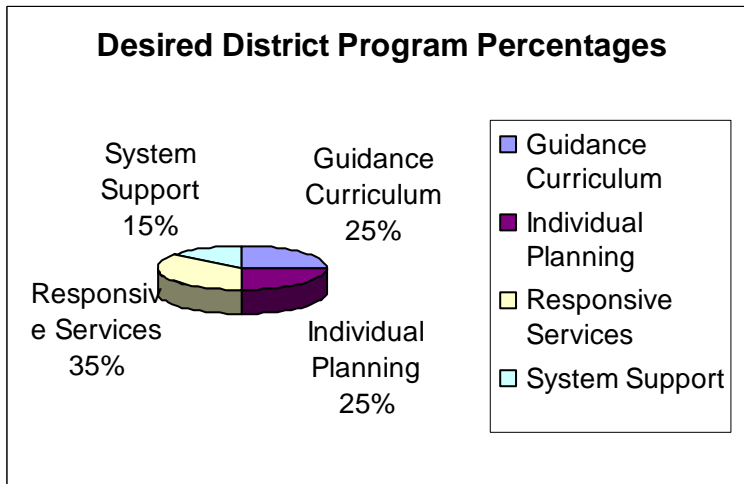

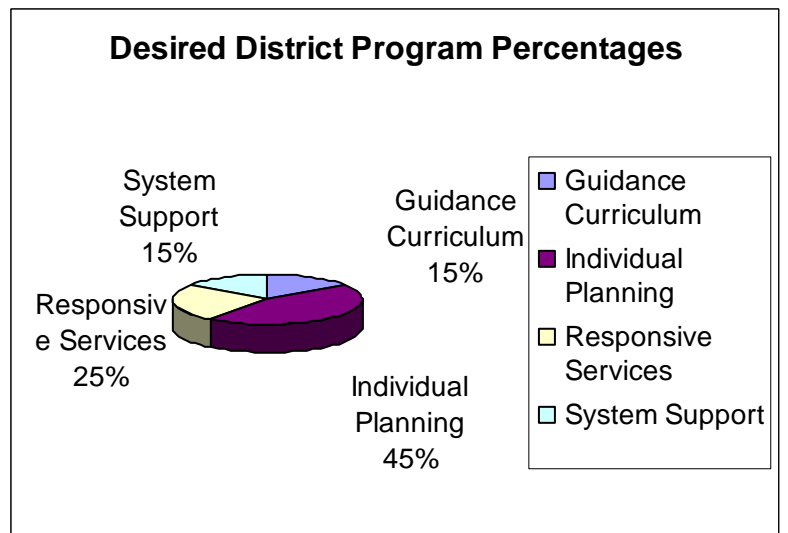
School Counselor Time Distribution
